Atlantic School of Theology is hiring a limited part-time appointment in Pastoral Theology. This half-time appointment includes the role of Acting Coordinator of Contextual Education including AST's Summer Distance Program. Contextual Education encompasses the practicum courses required for all degree programs at AST. These courses require students to work or volunteer in various congregational and ministry sites. The coordinator is responsible for working with students, supervisors, and placements.

The Summer Distance MDiv primarily prepares candidates for ministry in the United Church of Canada. Students from Anglican and United Church of Christ have also been enrolled. Familiarity with one of these denominations will be an asset.

Dates April 1, 2025 – Dec 31, 2026, with the possibility of an extension

Location Remote work is possible however presence on the AST campus in Halifax,

NS, during the summer term is required.
